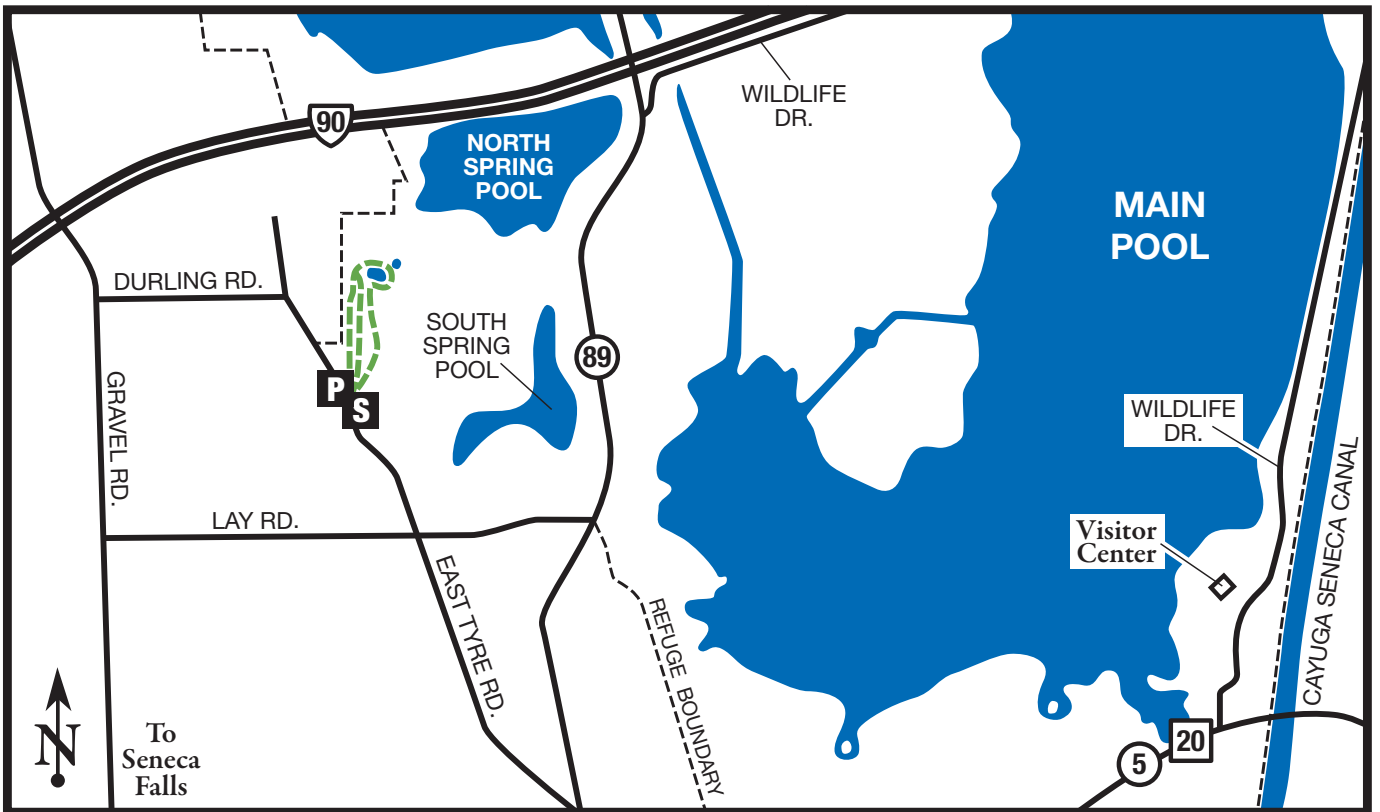
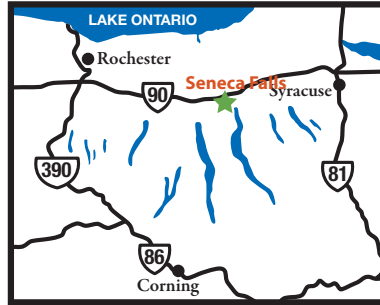


34 Montezuma National Wildlife Refuge Walking Trails - Seneca Falls, NY

Distance .75 to 1 mile
 Difficulty to ★★☆☆

One of the Northeast's most important wetland complexes and staging areas for migratory birds, Montezuma provides a critical habitat for all kinds of birds, including Bald Eagles and Trumpeter Swans. The extensive trail system at Montezuma offers mostly hard-packed dirt and grass paths surrounded by wildlife. Length of trails range from .75 mile to 1 mile and are mostly flat leaving the difficulty at a minimum.
